  - b. Declaration must be signed by the student with current date;
  - c. If ethics was required, a copy of the ethics clearance certificate must be included;
- 3. The signed supervisor submission form;
- 4. ETD form (signed by the supervisor)
- 5. List of corrections undertaken-with reference to specific lines, page numbers and chapters;
- 6. The HoD/HoS approval letter:
- 7. ETD payment receipt (only if research accounts for 50% or more of the qualification)

NB: Candidates who have submitted final work for inclusion in a Graduation Ceremony should <u>ensure that all fees are</u> <u>cleared at least six weeks</u> before the ceremony to which they are linked. **The next graduation will take place in December 2024**
